Recently, we've attended the Josephine County, Klamath County, and Siskiyou County livestock auctions.

This year, due to the effects and devastation from the McKinney Fire near Yreka, CA, our Southern Oregon community took immediate action and banded together to host the Siskiyou County Fair at the Jackson County Expo. In an effort to provide the resources needed, Grange Co-op assisted by coordinating and transporting livestock panels from the Siskiyou County Fairgrounds to the Jackson County Expo. These panels created the livestock show arena, allowing exhibitors to safely show and auction their projects.

MCKINNEY FIRE - EMERGENCY RELIEF EFFORTS





Providing emergency aid to a community in need, Grange Co-op delivered items to assist with fire relief from the McKinney Fire within Siskiyou County, CA. With many families, livestock, and pets displaced, a need to provide essential products to those affected quickly became apparent. Donations were dropped off at the

Siskiyou County Fairgrounds to benefit large livestock animals, Rescue Ranch for dogs, and Harts Rescue for cats.

Grange Co-op also provided the opportunity for customers to Round Up their transactions at checkout. Proceeds are contributed directly to local wildfire relief efforts.

Throughout the course of the program, young entrepreneurs learned how to start, own and operate their own business -- a lemonade stand! They learned business skills, financial literacy, goal setting and teamwork. This experience helps spark an explosion of new confidence in the participating children's abilities and a new vision of the possibilities for the future. Participants are encouraged to spend some, save some for the future and share some with a local non-profit of their



choice. There was a total of 42 stands throughout Grants Pass, giving around 200 kids the opportunity to operate their own business. We enjoyed having these kids bring some fun to our parking lot while they used the space to learn important life skills.
