BLUE CORDUROY CLASSIC



For the last four years, California FFA has hosted the annual Blue Corduroy Classic on January 31st. The virtual fundraiser features an online auction that benefits the cost of leadership conferences, career development events, and many other activities for young people that wear the Blue and Gold jackets. This year Grange Co-op donated a large cooler full of hunting and fishing supplies. In total, the auction reached thousands of supporters across the nation, and California FFA was able to raise \$25,000 in donations from this event!

YOUTH IN AG SUPPORT

Grange Co-op worked together with customers, members, and employees to donate over \$175,000 to youth in agriculture in 2021. Along with funds directly donated from Grange Co-op, customers' contributions via the round up program collected at point of sale helped donate to this initiative. Of the \$175,000 Grange Co-op donated over \$75,000 to local 4-H and FFA organizations. Of the \$75,000 donated to youth in agriculture organizations, Grange Co-op donated \$25,000 to Oregon FFA and \$10,000 to California FFA. Grange Co-op also donated \$10,000 each to Jackson, Josephine, Klamath, and



Yuba-Sutter 4-H. Grange Co-op is proud to support many of these students with the purchase of over \$100,000 dollars in project animals in the communities served. Grange Co-op prides itself

in helping reward students for their challenging work and we look forward to helping students achieve their goals and navigate 2022.
