All seven retail locations had donation bins set up in the stores to collect canned and non-perishable food items. In addition to the canned food drive, customers had the opportunity to round up their transaction totals at the registers, with the money raised going to food banks in their respective communities. This year, over 2,500 food items and \$11,000 were collected!

## SCHOLARSHIP WINDOW OPENING

Annually, Grange Co-op offers 9 scholarships, eight \$1,500 scholarships and one \$2,000 scholarship for a total of \$14,000 awarded to high school seniors in Jackson, Josephine, Klamath, Lake, Curry, Douglas, Siskiyou, Shasta, Tehama, Del Norte, Modoc, Yuba, Sutter, Colusa, Glenn, or Butte counties. The application window opened on November 1st and will close on January 31st. To qualify for these

scholarships, students must have a GPA of 3.50 or higher, and have participated in FFA, 4-H, Young Farmers, Horticulture, DECA, FBLA, student body leadership, sports, or non-related activities such as work experience.

## YUBA CITY, CA TURKEY DRIVE

On November 11th, Grange Co-op partnered with local Yuba City businesses to host the 15th annual Turkey Drive. The Turkey Drive ran November 9th through November 20th at 11 locations in Yuba City, Marysville, and Colusa. All turkeys collected will be going to 17 different organizations to help feed over 5,000 people in need.
